The team will consist of four residents. In addition to Krystyna the other three residents will act as coordinators for Neighbourhood Watch in Maisemore Gardens. Maggie Murphy(30) for houses 26-48
Shirley Cooke (74) for houses 49-74

In the event of any incident, **first and foremost**, the police must be contacted and advised. After that please advise a team member and, where applicable or necessary, a notification will be sent out to all the residents. This initially will be done either by leaflet drop if deemed extremely serious or urgent and via the Maisemore Gardens website and in time by email. It is estimated that approximately two thirds of residents have internet and email access and the team are looking to use email as a swift, practical, efficient and cost effective means of communication and it is hoped to compile an updated list of emails to enable us to achieve this. These details will be kept private and secure. Your help, support and cooperation in this is very much appreciated.

The team also hopes to work closely with other local bodies and Neighbourhood Watch schemes and the viability of reintroducing a newsletter which will give details of local developments is under review.
